

ORDINANCE 2019-OR2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART OF ARTICLE IX ENTITLED  
"STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING"  
OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC ON PUBLIC STREETS  
AND LIMITING TIMES OF PARKING UPON CERTAIN STREETS  
AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF  
AND REPEALING ALL OTHER SECTIONS  
OF ORDINANCE #124 AND #1023 IN CONFLICT HEREWITH:

WHEREAS, the City of Knox has previously regulated parking within the City of Knox; and

WHEREAS, the regulation of parking is necessary for the health and safety of the citizens of Knox; and

WHEREAS, current usage on certain streets in the City of Knox has changed over the years so that it is now necessary to amend prior ordinances:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KNOX that the Code of Ordinances be amended by amending and repealing certain sections of Article IX of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Knox, as follows:

- A) Section 9-274 entitled "Parking Adjacent to Schools" is hereby amended as follows:
  - (a) The City Council is hereby authorized to erect signs indicating "No Parking" or "Residential Parking Only" upon either or both sides of any street adjacent to any school property when such parking would, in the opinion of the Council, interfere with traffic, create a hazardous situation or impede a residential parking place.
- B) Section 9-281 entitled "Fines and Penalties except for court related matters" is hereby amended as follows:
  - (a) Any person violating sections 9-278, 9-279, and 9-280 would be subject to fines as follows:
    - (1) First and any subsequent offenses \$25.00 per violation.
