Absentee voting in person for the 2020 Presidential Primary Election will **BEGIN** at 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 26, 2020 at the Starke County Clerk's Office 2nd Floor of the Courthouse at 53 East Washington Street, Knox.

Absentee voting in person for the 2020 Presidential Primary Election will **END** at 12:00 p.m. (noon), Monday, June 1, 2020 at the Starke County Clerk's Office 2nd Floor of the Courthouse at 53 East Washington Street, Knox.

This is a County-wide election, and all eligible register voters in Starke County may participate in this Election.

Voters will need to show a photo ID that meets all of the following criteria:

- Displays the voter's photo,
- Displays the voter's name,
- Displays an expiration date, and must either be current, or have expired **after** November 6, 2018 **AND**
- Be issued by the State of Indiana, or the Federal Government.**

** In most cases, an Indiana driver's license, Indiana photo ID card, Military ID or U.S. Passport is sufficient. A student ID from an **Indiana state school** may only be used if it meets all of the 4 criteria specified above. A student ID from a private institution **may not** be used for voting purposes.
