On November 11, 2023 the Sheriff's Department received an attempt to locate of a rolling domestic violence situation that began in Starke County. Deputies located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. This led to the arrest of the driver, Kyle Back for Operating While Intoxicated. While conducting the investigation the passenger, Maggie Back was also arrested for Public Intoxication for her actions at the scene of the stop.

On November 16, 2023 a routine traffic stop led to the arrest of Thomas Hueston for Driving While Suspended.

During the 7 day period, Deputies of the Pulaski County Sheriff's Department logged 117 calls for service. Of the calls logged, 43 of them were traffic stops. Deputies also responded to a fire related incident, mental health calls, drowning incident, domestic disputes, roadway hazards, alarm calls, 16 crashes, and threats calls.
