On November 10, 2023 Deputies were called to a welfare check of a man staggering in a ditch near Winamac. This led to the arrest of David Rearick for a Parole Violation Warrant, and felony Possession of a Legend Drug.

On November 10, 2023 a traffic stop was conducted in the near the town of Denham which led to the arrest of Ricardo Juarez for misdemeanor Possession of a Controlled Substances.

(All subjects are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.)

During the 7 day period Pulaski County Sheriff's Deputies logged 167 calls for service. Of these calls 39 were traffic stops. Other calls for services included welfare checks, responding to a residential break in, animal complaints, checking on disabled vehicles, a drowning investigations, and several serious crashes.

Pulaski County Corrections is overseeing the care and custody of 106 inmates currently.
