On December 16, 2023 Deputies conducted a sex offender registry compliance check in the Monterey area. Upon arrival, the odor of marijuana was emitting from the residence. Mikayla Taylor was issued a misdemeanor summons for Possession of a Controlled Substance.

On December 16, 2023 Deputies received a report of a missing person in the Monterey area. Everything checked out okay with the incident. However, upon making contact with Preston Smith, he was in violation of his terms of sex offender registration. Preston was taken into custody for a Sex Offender Registration Violation.

On December 17, 2023 a Deputy was walking into the Good to Go gas station in Winamac. He smelled someone smoking marijuana in their vehicle in the parking lot. Cilas Wilson was issued a misdemeanor summons for Possession of Marijuana.

On December 17, 2023 Deputies were called to Francesville for an unwanted guest. The person, Alex Clemons was found to be in possession of stolen property. Alex was taken into custody.

On December 20, 2023 Deputies conducted a traffic stop in the Francesville area. This led to the Tina Smith being arrested for misdemeanor Driving While Suspended Prior.

On December 21, 2023 Deputies responded to a Domestic in Monterey. Ultimately, Jason Morningstar was issued a misdemeanor summons for Possession of Marijuana.

On December 22, 2023 Deputies conducted a traffic stop in the Winamac area. Alexander Mcdaniel was arrested for Possession of a Controlled Substance. K-9 Loki assisted in the search of the vehicle.

(ALL SUBJECTS ARE PRESUMED INNOCENT UNTIL PROVEN GUILTY IN A COURT OF LAW.)

During the 7 day stretch, Deputies logged 139 calls for service. Of the calls 51 of them were traffic stops.

Pulaski County Dispatch logged the following calls for service for the 7 day period:
