Shall Culver Community Schools Corporation increase property taxes paid to the school corporation for no more than eight (8) years for the purpose of funding and sustaining educational and operational funding stability in response to reductions in property tax revenue, including maintaining student safety, health, and well-being initiatives; attracting, retaining, and supporting teachers and staff; maintaining class sizes; and funding academic and support programs to meet the educational needs of all students, by imposing a property tax rate that does not exceed \$0.24 and results in a maximum annual amount that does not exceed \$2,899,000? If this operating referendum public question is approved by the voters, for a median residence of \$200,000, the property's annual property tax bill would increase by \$208 per year. The most recent operating referendum public question proposed by the school corporation was held in November 2018 and passed.
